The first part of the training is taken online, which allows employees to learn at their own pace. Participants also have the option of going through the course in an abbreviated format and testing out of lessons with which they may already be familiar. Red Cross Web-based training can be stopped and started according to busy work schedules, and students have access to online content for one year so that they may refresh their skills at any time.

The second part of the course can be led by a Red Cross-trained instructor on your staff, or your local chapter can provide an instructor for you. This approximately two-hour skills practice and assessment will ensure that your employees learn the skills necessary to save a life in an emergency.
